Thank you for your interest in the Dreams Come True of Jacksonville Moore Scholarship.

We are happy that Dreams Come True can further support a Dreamer's sibling in their pursuit of a college degree or technical/trade school certificate. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded annually in May by our DCT Scholarship Board.

All applicants must meet the basic requirements established below:

- 2.75 High School GPA or 2.5 College GPA
- Must be the sibling of a child who has officially been referred and is/has participated in the Dreams Come True program
- Eligible students include high school seniors or those attending community college, a four-year university, graduate school or a technical institution/trade school and are under the age of 24.

Students wishing to apply for the Dreams Come True of Jacksonville Moore Scholarship must submit a completed application, **via mail or in person**, no later than **Friday, April 9, 2027**. The DCT Scholarship Board will review all applications and the scholarship will be announced and awarded in May. **No applications will be accepted via email.**

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Application for Dreams Come True of Jacksonville Moore Scholarship

1. **APPLICATION FORM** – Must be completed and signed by applicant. This must be typed or legibly written. Formal candidacy can only be established upon the receipt of a completed application.
2. **PERSONAL RECOMMENDATION LETTERS** – Candidates should submit three (3) personal recommendation letters completed by counselors, principals, teachers, religious leaders, coaches, and/or community leaders. All references should be current and specific to this scholarship.
3. **ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT** – An official high school transcript must be in a sealed envelope. If a candidate has graduated from high school, a copy of their high school transcript and a current college transcript, along with any employment activities since graduation should be included.
4. **PERSONAL STATEMENTS** – Two (2) personal statements: 1. one describing obstacles overcome and why you are deserving of consideration for this scholarship; 2. the other should be about the impact of DCT on your Dreamer sibling and your family.
5. **STANDARDIZED TEST RESULTS** – Please include ACT and/or SAT scores in the application packet. Scores that appear on a sealed transcript or in a sealed envelope from a guidance counselor will be accepted.
6. **LIST OF EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES/HONORS AND AWARDS** – this would include any sports teams, church groups, volunteer organizations, employment that the application is involved in.
7. **CURRENT PHOTOGRAPH** – Please submit a current photo.
